



## Sector Scheme 12D T4 Training Course

### 12D T4 Convoy Working Training Course

<b>Duration</b>	One Day
<b>Group Size</b>	Maximum 12 delegates x 1 Instructor Maximum 6 delegates x 1 Assessor
<b>Who Should Attend</b>	12D T4 is targeted at all persons needing to become a registered Traffic Management Convoy Working Operative as described in Sector Scheme document 12D.
<b>Course Aims</b>	To provide delegates with the necessary underpinning technical knowledge and skill to convoy work on all 2 way roads and dual carriageway roads restricted to 40mph or less
<b>Prerequisites</b>	Delegates must be qualified in 12D T1 & T2 prior to attending the 12D T4 course
<b>Course Objectives</b>	On completion of the session delegates will: - <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Be aware of sector schemes</li><li>• Be aware of health &amp; safety at work</li><li>• Be aware of risk assessments &amp; method statements</li><li>• Be aware of relevant codes of practice and other associated documentation when involved in traffic management</li><li>• Identify the equipment required in temporary traffic management</li><li>• Understand the requirements for convoy working</li><li>• Understand how convoy systems operate</li></ul>
<b>Certification</b>	On completion all delegates will be required to undertake a multiple choice examination which carries a 75% pass mark. Lantra Awards (the national awarding body) will issue a certificate to successful candidates. Candidates will be awarded 12D module T4 after successful completion of one site based assessment with a suitably qualified assessor in accordance with the awarding body's scheme rules. Refresher training is required every 5 years to keep your training updated and valid.
