



## Sector Scheme 12D T6 Training Course Registered Lead Traffic Management Operative Training Course

<b>Duration</b>	Two Days
<b>Group Size</b>	Maximum 8 delegates x 1 Instructor Maximum 12 delegates x 2 Instructors
<b>Who Should Attend</b>	All Registered Traffic Management Operatives (RTMO) as described in Sector Scheme Document 12D who wish to become a Registered Lead Traffic Management Operative (RLTMO).
<b>Course Aims</b>	To provide delegates with the necessary underpinning technical knowledge and skill to supervise a gang or gangs (as appropriate).
<b>Course Objectives</b>	On completion of the session delegates will: - <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Have a working knowledge of National Highway Sector Schemes.</li><li>• Realise the importance and relevance of health &amp; safety at work.</li><li>• Have a working knowledge of the relevant codes of practice and other associated documentation when involved in traffic management.</li><li>• Provide evidence that they understand the differences between Chapter and the Safety at Street Works and Road Works (red book) and how these apply.</li><li>• Understand the risk assessment process and be able to carry out risk assessments &amp; method statements on works involving traffic management.</li><li>• Be able to demonstrate their knowledge of their Supervisory responsibilities.</li><li>• Have the ability to assess the suitability of equipment for the use on the highway.</li><li>• Be able to monitor site and recommend action as condition change.</li><li>• Be able ascertain when management intervention is required.</li></ul>
<b>Certification</b>	On completion all delegates will be required to undertake an examination consisting two test papers which carries a 75% pass mark. Lantra Awards (the national awarding body) will issue a card to successful candidates. Refresher training is required every 5 years to keep your card valid.
