



Sector Scheme 12D T7 Training Course 12D T7 For Managers and Client Officers Training Course

Duration	Two Days
Group Size	Maximum 8 delegates x 1 Instructor Maximum 12 delegates x 2 Instructors
Who Should Attend	12D T7 is targeted at all levels of Management, Client Officers, Technicians and any person not actually installing Temporary Traffic Management (TTM), but requiring a knowledge of basic practice of TTM on urban and rural roads.
Course Aims	To provide delegates with the necessary underpinning knowledge of temporary traffic management and the design procedures used for this within Highway Authorities, Contractors, and for other organisations who require a knowledge of current basic practice with minimum legal requirements where they apply.
Course Objectives	On completion of the session delegates will: - <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Have a working knowledge of National Highway Sector Schemes.• Interpret the requirements of 'The Safety at Street Works and Road Works, A Code of Practice (The Red Book)' and further guidance from 'The Traffic Signs Manual, Chapter 8'• Consider all options available to determine the level and extent of the Temporary Traffic Management required.• Demonstrate knowledge of the site risk assessment process.• Have the ability to assess and determine temporary traffic layout required for a given work location, activity or operation.• Understand the standard of equipment that is acceptable to use.• Realise the implications of changing conditions on site.• Have the confidence to liaise with site staff for appropriate remedial actions.• Have the ability to confirm suitability of TTM plans prior to work starting on site.
Certification	On completion all delegates will be required to undertake a written examination which carries a 75% pass mark. Lantra Awards (the national awarding body) will issue a certificate to successful candidates with the option of purchasing a card. Refresher training is required every 5 years to keep your certificate or card valid.
